BATTLE RULES AND INFORMATION

The Battle of the Books is a reading incentive program in which students read books from a predetermined list. The books are selected from SC Award Book nominees. Teams of students will then compete by answering questions from the books.



Students may help choose their teams—five members and at least one alternate. Some teams try to have all members read every book; others divide the books up with each member responsible for being the authority on several

books. Students begin reading the books and participating on the book blog in the fall. In January, we begin practicing questions. During February and March, we form teams and hold playoffs culminating with the school team winner. That winning team will go on to represent Sterling at the District Championships held in April. 
